White Wines

Jordan Blanc fume R83.50

(2)  

Sauvignon Blanc, barrel-fermented in French and American oak barrels. A rich and sophisticated wine, ripe fig, gooseberry and tropical fruit flavours are complemented by the gentle vanilla nuances of the oak.

Fleur du cap sauvignon Blanc R63.00

(1)  

This sauvignon has loads of green capsicum and an intriguing touch of gunflint on the nose. On the palate it is bone dry and assertive: a real show off!

Rietvallei chardonnay R64.00

(3)   

On the nose this wine has appealing roasted citrus aromas with vibrant and prominent lime flavours. On the palate it is well balanced with rich citrus flavours and subtle oak. With its long finish an added toastiness emerges.

Villiera Chenin Blanc R80.00

(3)  

Fruity and dry, with a vibrant and tropical bouquet of flavours, this wine is one of the Cape's best-crafted and most delicious examples.

Ken Forrester Petit Chenin R49.50

(4) 

A wine for anytime. Fresh, ripe melon and honey-suckle fruit are the dominant flavours in this gently-dry white with a refreshingly long finish.

Simonsig Gewürztraminer R55.50

(6)  

You are greeted with fragrant rose petals, with the palate holding a seductive silk-textured sweetness then finishing with length.

Nederburg Rhine Riesling R54.00

(5)  

This off-dry white is enticingly aromatic, with a floral aroma boosted by a crisp, racy tail. The flavours are reminiscent of a fleshy quince.

Zevenwacht "The Tin Mine" White R90.00

(3)  

A rich blend of Sauvignon Blanc, Chardonnay and Viognier. Complex and luscious with creamy citrus and tropical fruit.

Graham Beck "Waterside" White R53.50

(4)   

Plump and peachy, this is a smooth-textured and tasty blend of Chardonnay and Colombard.

Angels Tears White R47.50

(5)  

A seductive blend of Muscat d'Alexandrie and Chenin Blanc with exotic peach, apricot and honeysuckle flavours. This wine is a great match for any occasion – exquisite alone or simply enjoy with your friends and family.

Zevenwacht Bouquet Blanc R58.50

(6)  

This off-dry charmer is an aromatic marriage of equal parts Gewürztraminer and Riesling and is fragrant and floral on the nose. Fruit cocktail flavours follow on the palate.

TJ Night Nectar R45.00

(6)  

A fresh, graceful sweetie with delicate acidity. The blend is mostly Chenin Blanc with a touch of Viognier. Its low alcohol content makes it perfect for lunch.

Red Wines

Zonnebloem Cabernet sauvignon R79.50

(E) 

Not so forthcoming on the nose, but the palate is handsomely cloaked in a dark mulberry ripeness, which adds context to the fine-grained tannins and the lingering, dry finish.

Porcupine Ridge merlot R77.00

(D) 

A full bodied red with coffee, chocolate and spicy vanilla undertones. It is elegant and rich with a lengthy finish.

Porcupine Ridge Syrah R90.50

(D) 

A ripe and round wine delivers up-front fruit, bursting with spice, prunes and black pepper. The powerful flavours are accompanied by a rich and full-bodied finish.

Beyerskloof Pinotage R68.00

(C)  

A tasty, fresh wine that has enough ripe firmness to hold the cherry and red-berry fruit in a well-calculated grip. Eminently drinkable with a tight finish.

Ken Forrester "Petit" Pinotage R60.00

(B) 

Juicy and unwooded in style, this wine has a pulpy essence of variety; brambleberries and rhubarb provide perky, uncomplicated drinking pleasure.

Kaapzicht Bin 3 R97.50

(D) 

This balanced and accessible blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Pinotage is crammed with dark berry flavours, and an underlying chocolaty richness. It is sleek and fat; amicable and just waiting to please.

Flagstone Longitude R51.50

(B) 

On the nose there is an explosion of sweet cherry and ripe raspberry, with a background of spicy vanilla. The palate is all about silky tannins and bright berry flavours. It finishes in a flourish of plum and chocolate.

Chateau Libertas R45.00

(B) 

This wine, the Grandfather of South African blends, tends to the European style, with plums and minerals on the nose. The palate is firm and markedly dry, leaving you with an aromatic fynbos farewell.

Douglas Green St Augustine R62.50

(C)  

Upon addressing this wine you are greeted by a warm and generous plummy aroma. The finish is smooth, superior and juicy.

Graham Beck Railroad Red R67.50

(C)  

A perennial favourite, this easy-drinking red blend is characterized by a rich Shiraz nose and Cabernet berry flavours, and portrays subtle fruit tannins on the palate.

Boekenhoutskloof "The Wolftrap" R55.50

(C) 

A spicy, aromatic blend of Merlot, Grenache, Syrah, Ruby Cabernet, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cinsaut. Full-bodied and smooth, its light body highlights wild, red fruit juiciness. Vin out of the *ordinaire*.

Sparkling Wines

JC le Roux La Domaine R60.00

A sweet party fizzer with floral and spicy muscat tones, and a lively bead.

Sparkling Wines Continued...

JC le Roux La Chanson R60.00

A big-volume ruby-hued sweet sparkler with abundant berry fruit flavours from red blend varieties. The tannins provide contrast, and absorb some of the sweetness.

Pongracz R97.00

An applauded brut-style non-vintage Méthode Cap Classique (SA's champagne method) with an idiosyncratic sea-spray bouquet. It's bracing acidity lengthens to a persistent, appley finish.

Krone Borealis R113.50

A poetic blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, this M.C.C. has an elegant, classic biscuity bouquet with yeasty creaminess and fine, persistent bubbles.

Villiera Tradition Rose R130.00

A full-bodied blend of Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Pinotage. Classically made with simple fruity aromas and a poised finish.

Nederburg R41.50

(4) 

Made from Cinsaut, this off-dry mouthful of dominant cranberry is fruit flecked and finishes neat and crisp.

The Wolftrap R52.50

(3) 

A delectable mélange of Grenache, Shiraz and Cinsaut. Fresh and spicy with a lengthy finish.

Boschendal Blanc de Noir R60.50

(5)  

An attractively off-dry salmon-coloured wine with notes of strawberries and boiled-sweets.

Flagstone Semaphore R55.50

(4) 

Complexities of sweet and floral aromas on the nose coincide with those of pineapple, butterscotch and Turkish delight. The nose carries through to the pallet with the Butterscotch and Turkish delight insuring a full, creamy mouth-feel with a well balanced acidity to the fruit.
